At Home & On The Highway: Broad Tariffs Threaten To Make Daily Life More Expensive

Inflation rose for the fourth month in a row according to the latest Consumer Price Index (CPI) report¹, and Americans are seeking relief from the financial squeeze of rising prices. With the threat of broad tariffs looming, Americans are rightfully concerned. Whether filling up your gas tank, buying a new car or feeding your family, tariffs could make everyday goods more expensive for working-class families.

At the Pump and On the Road:



The tariffs on Mexico, Canada and China would add about six percent, or \$2,700, to the average U.S. vehicle price.²



Tariffs on Canadian crude oil could **increase** gas prices nationally by an average of 15 cents per gallon.³⁴

At Home:



Most U.S. households would see their **taxes** increase by more than \$1,200 a year and will spend an additional \$362 to \$624 annually. 56



Groceries, including **fresh fruit and vegetables**, could increase significantly in price.⁹



Trade policy could also impact the price of heating costs, with some households seeing a price bump for home heating oil of **20 to 30** cents per gallon this winter.⁷



An \$80 pair of jeans could cost \$10 to \$16 more. A \$100 coat could cost \$12 to \$21 more. 10



Major kitchen appliances, such as refrigerators and ovens, are expected to increase in cost by five to 10 percent.8



Sneakers could jump in price between \$18 and \$20.11



Drugstore beauty brands may increase **their** prices by three percent.¹²
